Largest group: four hundred fifty-three million

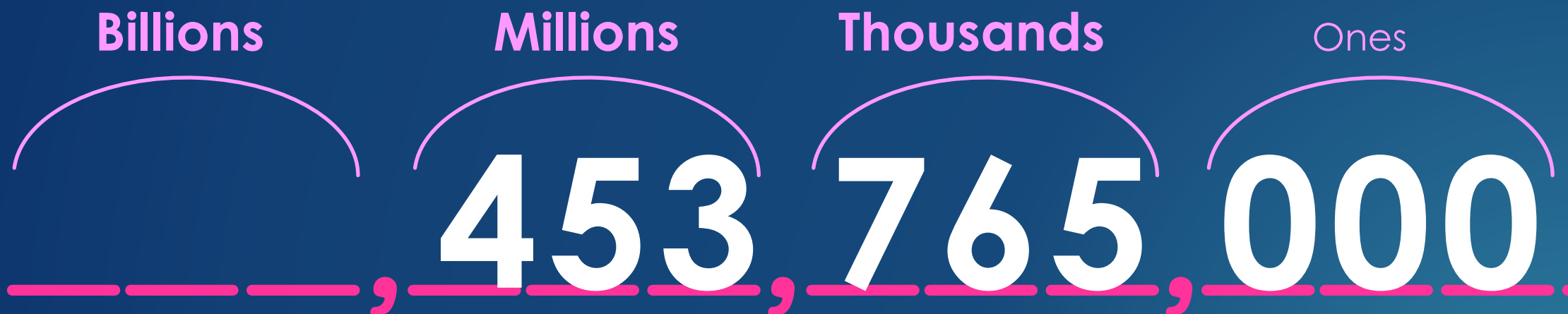
Second group: seven hundred sixty-five thousand

This number is...

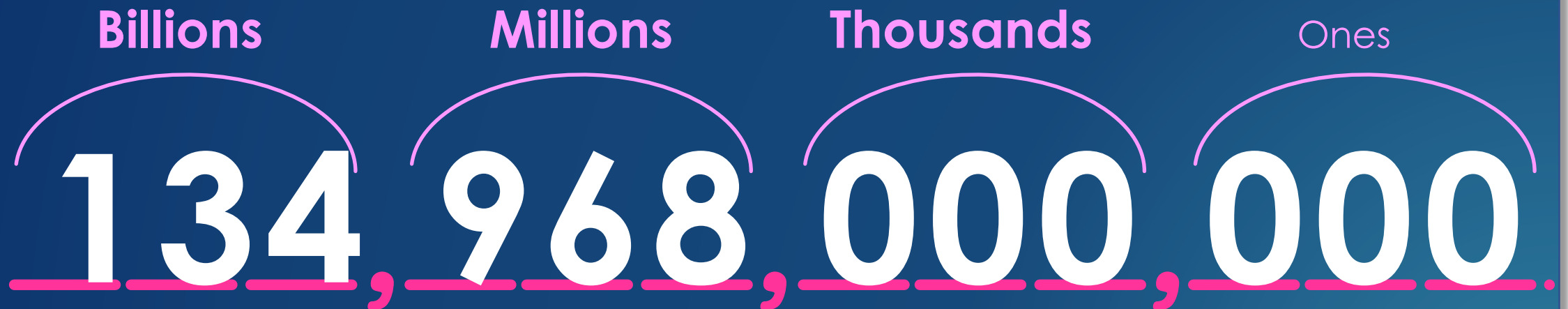
four hundred fifty-three million seven hundred sixty-five thousand

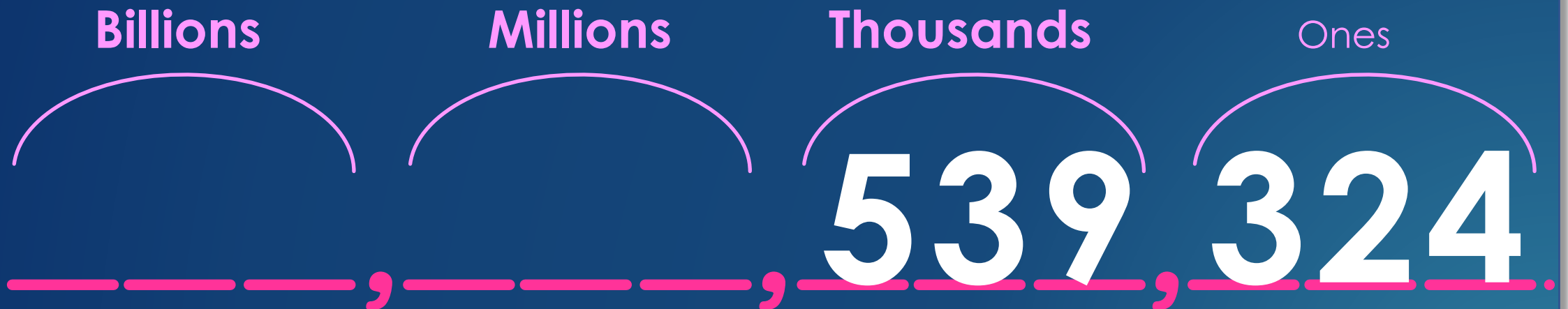
Don't forget – you do not name the ones group name!
